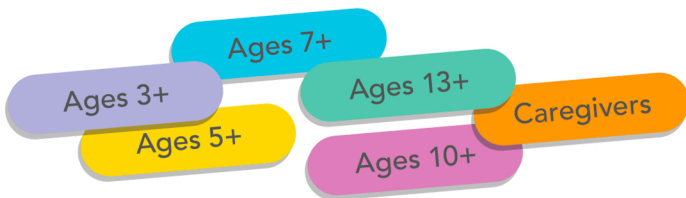

HAVING THE TALKS

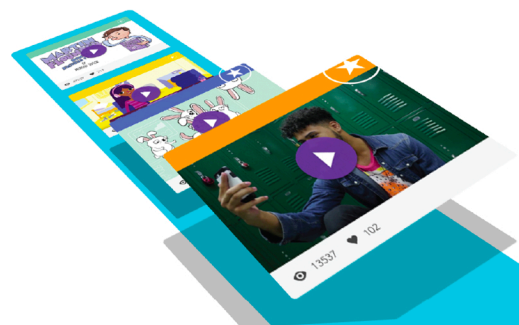
Not sure how to start a conversation about sexual health and development with your child? Having the Talks is a series of videos that provides a model for how to do so appropriately and effectively.
